I hope everyone and your families are safe. The COVID-19 situation continues to evolve, and a third wave appears to have hit Saskatchewan. The arrival of COVID variants has increased the risk to families and friends. The Saskatchewan Health Authority has issued health orders effective April 13, 2021 that household bubbles are limited to immediate households. No guest or other gathering is allowed at this time. It is also strongly recommended to avoid unnecessary travel. Technically we are still allowed to meet in our lodge buildings as long as we do not exceed 30 people. However, variant cases continue to rise daily in several areas in Saskatchewan and this is a real concern of mine. The safety of our members and families is first and foremost in my mind.

Therefore, effective April 19, 2021, all in-person Lodge meetings within the jurisdiction of the Grand Lodge of Saskatchewan are to cease until further notice.

I am hoping that this pause in activities will only need to be in effect for a couple of weeks. I ask everyone to be patient and get vaccinated as soon as you are able to for your own safety and all of us. Let us do our part and **“Stick it to COVID.”**
